What to do:

The plants require pulling/cutting at the end of May/June. Pulling could continue into July. Once pulled/cut they can be left to rot.

When cutting, the stems must be cut at ground level under the first leaf node to ensure no further growth for that season. Eradication could be possible within 3 years if dealt with properly. **It is important that you don't get disillusioned.**

Small areas of infestation can be controlled by pulling the plant that is only shallow-rooted and composting providing there are no seeds present.
